



Golley Memorial Scholarship



This award honors the late Frank Golley, director of the Savannah River Ecology Laboratory from 1962-1967 and director of the Institute of Ecology from 1968-1979. An internationally acclaimed leader in the field of landscape ecology, he published more than 150 papers and more than 40 books and chapters on topics in ecology, biology, social sciences, and history.

The Golley award has a significant monetary allotment. This award can be used in its full amount on research and travel if applied through the Odum School of Ecology, or can be distributed through your payroll (and taxed) if directly received. This money is not available until August and the recipient must be enrolled during that time.

Applicants for this one-time monetary scholarship must meet the following criteria:

1. Graduate student in an Odum School of Ecology graduate program (master's or doctorate)
